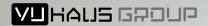

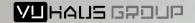

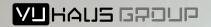

We are an **affiliate-based network** of public radio stations from across the country, deeply rooted in our local music communities.

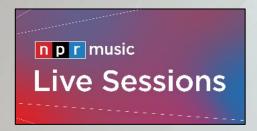
We share a common mission to support artists and be a source of **music discovery** for audiences around the world.

We are non-profit and non-commercial, and our aim is to be true partners to **artists and stations**.

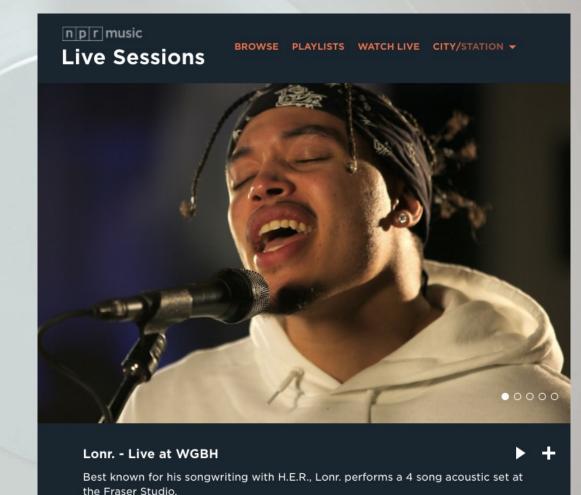

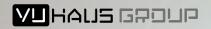


CONTENT DISTRIBUTION: AFFILIATE STATION CITY PAGES

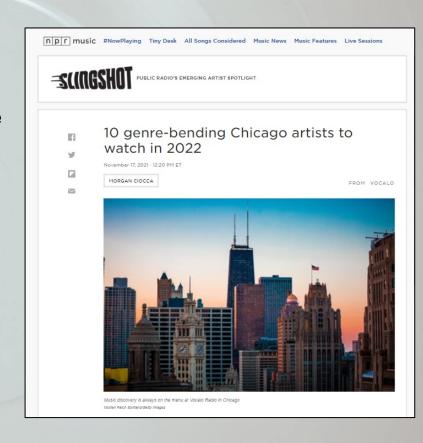

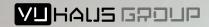




STATION COLLABORATIONS

- In 2017, NPR Music and VuHaus' public radio network launched "Slingshot," a collective editorial effort among taste-making music stations to elevate exceptional emerging artists.
- Slingshot 2022 launches in January with stations collaborating on "Artists To Watch 2022" list and continues with NPR editorial updates including "Slingshot Scenes," "#NowPlaying" and "Station Breaks."
- Other station collaborations include: SXSW stages, Public Radio Music Day, 'Songs For Change', The Black Church: This is Our Story, This is Our Song

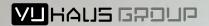

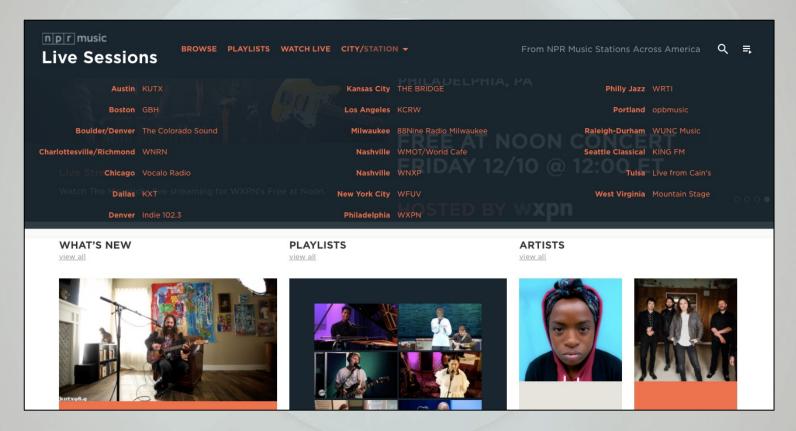
